Mind's support model

Our staff assist you with daily life tasks and develop skills for independent living - including helping you to connect with activities and other supports in the community. Support is tailored to help achieve the goals in your NDIS Plan. Mind is the nominated support provider. Tenancy and Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) is managed separately by a third-party agent.

About our residences

We are able to support you in accommodation that best suits your needs and funding arrangements and our specialist complex support teams help assess individual support needs. This includes allied health professionals.

We are looking to expand our existing partnerships with SDA providers and are open to explore new opportunities to provide our specialised support to individuals with complex support needs and their families and carers.

Applications are now open

This support service is designed for people whose capacity to live independently is impacted by disability and long-term mental health and wellbeing concerns. This support is for people experiencing complexity, both at an individual and a systems level.

Participants must:

- be between 18-64 years of age
- have the financial means to pay for rent and utilities
- have an NDIS plan to fund Supported Independent Living or SDA
- require support to be able to live independently and manage positive mental health and wellbeing.
